

An Act to Care for Those Disabled by Native Attacks, 1644

ACT IX.

WHEREAS in the late expeditions against the Indians, diverse men were hurt and maymed and disabled from provideing for their necessary maintenance and subsistance, *Be it therefore enacted by the authority of this present Grand Assembly,* That all hurt or maymed men be releived and provided for by the severall counties, where such men reside or inhabitt.
