

Confederate Parole Slip, 1865

Appomattox Court House, Virginia. April 10th, 1865.

The Bearer, Captain James M. Garnett and Ord. Officer Grimes Division, Confederate Officer Regiment 2nd Corps ANV, a paroled prisoner of the Army of Northern Virginia, has permission to go to his home and there remain undisturbed with his horse and servants.
