


✓ I Abner Burnley of the County of Louisa do make an ordain this as my last will and testament in manner and form as follows, after my just debts are paid my wish and desire is that my estate of every description be equally divided amongst my three brothers Henry, Seth, and Zachariah and my sister Ann Burnley. My desire is that my Executor pay my debts out of my lands, and other property so that my slaves may be divided amongst my three brothers & my sister as above written and provision be made to support and keep together my old man Robin & his wife Sucky. Lastly I appoint my two brothers Henry M and Seth Burnley as my Executors to this my will & Testament with power to see my lands and property as above mentioned. Given from under my hand and seal this the 10th day of January 1844.
