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COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA } **To-wit:**
CITY OF DANVILLE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT WE Paul Price
 PRINCIPAL, and Stafford Harris + Ella Kate Harris
 surety, are held and firmly bound unto Commonwealth of Virginia
 in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$ 500.00)
 to the payment whereof well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, personal representa-
 tives, and successors, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. And WE hereby waive all legal
 exemptions as to this BOND.

THE CONDITIONS OF THIS BOND ARE: That the said PRINCIPAL shall appear before the
Corporation Court of Danville on June 24, 1963
 at 2:30 o'clock P. M., and at such time(s) as may be prescribed by the Court or to which the
 proceedings may be continued or further heard, and before any Court thereafter having or holding
 any proceedings in connection with the charge, to answer for the offense charged against him, and not
 depart thence without leave of said Court; and this BOND is to remain in full force and effect until
 the charge is finally disposed of or until this BOND is declared void by order of a competent Court.

NON-APPEARANCE OF THE PRINCIPAL, if the offense be a misdemeanor, shall be deemed to
 constitute a waiver of trial by jury in any Court of Record; and we, the parties hereto, do hereby
 constitute and appoint the Commonwealth's Attorney for the City of Danville
 our Attorney in fact for the purpose, and do hereby authorize him, in the event of default in any ob-
 ligation of this BOND, to confess judgment against each of us in the Clerk's Office of Danville, Vir-
 ginia in favor of Commonwealth of Virginia for the amount of this BOND, together
 with the costs of such proceedings, including a \$10.00 attorney's fee. And we do hereby expressly waive
 any and all requirements of notice of such confession of judgment as may be required by Sec. 8-362
 of the Code of Virginia, or any subsequent act amendatory thereto. WE, and EACH of us, do hereby
 acknowledge that we have read and understand the obligations of this BOND.
