## **Confederate Parole Pass, 1865**

Paroled Prisoner's Pass Appomattox Court House, Va. April 10th, 1865.

The Bearer, Capt. James M. Garnett, Ordnance Officer Grimes' Div., 2nd Corps ANV [Army of Northern Virginia], a Paroled Prisoner of the Army of Northern Virginia, has permission to go to his home, and there remain undisturbed, with his horse & servants.
