Statement

The person, whose signature appears below: Jozsef Estefan, currently resident of Osaka, Va., North America, under oath I state that it is my wish that my daughter

Estefan Roza, 18 years old,

Presently residing in Kisvarda, Szaboles County, Hungary to join me in the United States of America.

I further state, that in case the above named will join me, I will take care of her, including her moral life. Until she is able to support herself financially, I promise to support her in every aspect. If it becomes necessary in the future, I accept the responsibility of paying for her return to her homeland and will not ask for reimbursement of these expenses. I also accept the responsibility that she will not be a burden for the United States in any way.

Finally, I state that I have a steady satisfactory income and I will be able to live up to my above mentioned responsibilities. My average monthly income is \$100.00
